

## Comments relating to Q1-5

Sometimes, Chi Man get's distracted especially during the beginning of class and it's hard to follow the lesson.






## Comments relating to Q6-11

Chi Man is one of the instructors that actually care about his students. He goes above and beyond for each of his students. He is awesome.



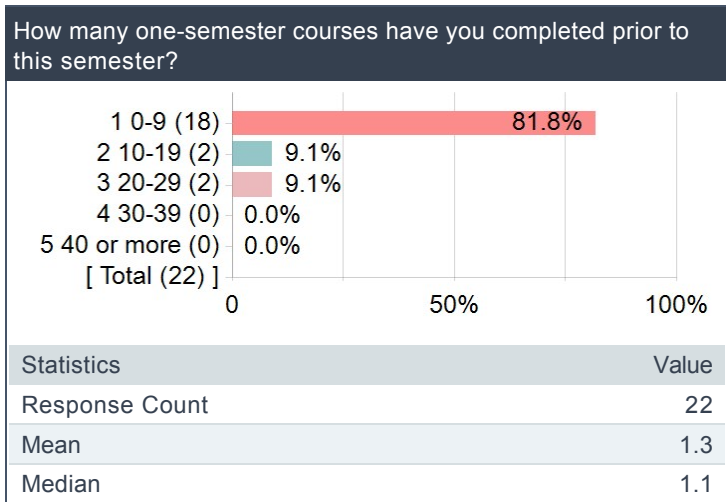
### Comments regarding course

There is always extra work, or examples to further my understanding of the topic.

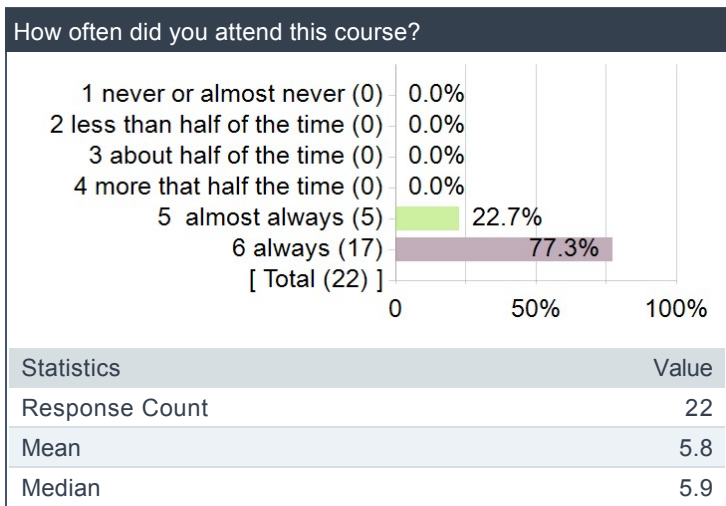
