He was always willing to take extra time to review concerns and questions that students had and would not move on until everyone was comfortable. If someone needed extra help, he was always willing to meet outside of class to help.

I really appreciate concern of instructor and obvious efforts, but the online experience is challenging. He sometimes doesn't understand when questions are asked and goes on with explanations that aren't helpful. Although there's opportunity to get extra help during the week, other courses conflict with time options, so when I do majority of homework – Fridays to Sundays, there is no assistance. Usually assignments are due Sundays so that gives me no opportunity to resolve issues before being evaluated. I feel very frustrated near the end of the class because there are so many times during the three hours where I end up getting confused, even though I could understand concept. I cry after class and by the time I am done an assignment. I have to withdraw from another course to try to keep up with this and it is frustration, because the time I am spending is mostly self-taught from outside sources. Perhaps he could slow down after concepts (before he reiterates several times because that just gets us more confused) and include the formulas with the explanations.

This teacher has gone out of his way to be helpful to me during the term.

He is using Zoom for online classes, I would like to have every prof to use same platform as Google meeting as our accounts are on Google platform which makes it just easier. Also would like for lectures to be recorded (if no one is opposed). For some people as myself, it is easier to understand material when listening few times. I prefer not to bug prof online too much as it slows the process for others. Recording of lectures really helps to get back to the material when working on home work alone.



Chi Man is an amazing professor. He was very responsive to my emails when I was unclear on concepts, and made attending class enjoyable.




CMY is readily available to answer any questions pertaining economics and shows a genuine interest for each and every student's progress/success.




Comments regarding course

Durians!
The course assignments might align with the goals, but they don't always correspond to what I have learned in class. I understand concepts as explained and I appreciate Chi Man's great sense of humour and his efforts. However, because it gets confusing and it's really fast, I would be completely lost without the textbook and other outside internet sources. I often rely on related lessons where I am never sure I got it right, like Khan Academy videos, for more thorough and clearer explanation. The textbook assignments are helpful, but I don't always understand even after solutions are given (since they lack explanation). The maple assignments are helpful, but having three attempts doesn't really help because if I don't get it the first time, why would I magically get the same problem the second/third time (given there often isn't opportunity for assistance between attempts when I can do my homework (Thursday to Sunday); I just repeat the same mistakes so it becomes even more frustrating. I cry after every exam, even if I've ended up doing okay with it. When I am finished, I don't know what I did right or wrong. Sometimes it is just a guess. It does help after I have the grades to be able to look details of exam and incorrect answers. I can then figure it out, so hopefully I will have learned something, even if my grade doesn't reflect it.

Slides for the course are minimal, have to do online search more. No recordings of lecture, constant print screen not to miss the drawings.
In my degree, I have never had so many recommendations for a professor. My fellow students told me to take him – and no one else. And they were right. His understanding of economics is very high level yet he is able to dumb it down for us students with real-world experiences – I would trust anything he says in regards to economics. I found the course material to be more difficult than expected, though Chi Man was able to explain the concepts in a simple way, as well as make the assignments pertinent without being overly difficult.


Course Priority
